Introducing the 75 Squadron RAF/RNZAF Association Folio Wallet.

During my travels to meet the many 75 Squadron WW2 veterans and members, I have noticed that our Newsletters, Rules, Constitution and other Squadron forms have been stored in folders or envelopes or generally become waste. Therefore I have designed an A4 sized 'wallet' that can hold up to 60 pages of A4, and can be placed in a book shelf upright. The cover design is to recognise the 75 Squadron history in pictorial. The front cover shows the Wellington bomber and its pilot crew from 1941, while flying out of the page is the Squadrons last aircraft - the MCDonnell Douglas Skyhawk with a full Kahu weapons fit. The A4 pilot is Flt Lt Paul Barlow. The front cover also features the squadrons three badges from 1943 to 2001. The pilots wings brevet is from the WW2 era with the Tudor crown of King George VI.

On the back of the wallet is a mixture of the Squadrons history. The original Squadron Standard being addressed by HRH The Queen mother in 1958, and then the squadrons second standard paraded at the Disbandment day ceremony on 13 December 2001 at RNZAF Ohakea.

The log book entry of pilot Flying Officer Alex Simpson records his flight of the 101st operation of JN-M (NE181), M for Mike on the 5th of January 1945. The colour insert picture of the ground-crew putting up that Op on her nose is from a painting by John Marshall. The Vampire T11 pilot is Ross Ewing, while the Vampire crews sit on an FB5 from the earlier era. Canberra's at Tengah bracket the squadron in 1961, with Canberra pilot Comyn McAllister leaning on the hatch. The Mosquito group shot is likely the first of the RNZAF 75 Squadron. The group colour squadron photo in front of the two Skyhawks was the last 75 Squadron group ever taken, in June 2001.
